

# Adding on a Hundred Chart

You can use a hundred chart to add.  
To add  $37 + 26$ , follow these steps:

- Start at 37.
- Go down 2 rows to add 20.
- Go right 3 spaces to add 3 more.  
So far you have added  $20 + 3$ , or 23.
- To add 3 more, go down to the next row and go right 3 spaces.
- You end at 63.

So,  $37 + 26 = 63$ .

You could also do it this way:

- Start at 37.
- Go down 3 rows to add 30.
- Go left 4 spaces to subtract 4.
- You end at 63.

So,  $37 + 26 = 63$
